

Unit 8: Final Project: Instructions, Project Requirements, & Rubric

Instructions/Requirements:

1. During the year you developed a variety of components crucial for a nation's sovereignty; from the drafting of the constitution to the development of a Code of Laws. The final project is the cumulative of the units surveyed in the government/civics course. This project will allow you to get familiar with an online web builder. The final project is to be equivalent to your senior research paper; therefore, you need to create an almost flawless product that demonstrates your research and writing skills.
2. Requirements:
 - I. Must cover all the units surveyed during this course
 - II. There must be a separate page for each unit covered.
 - III. The units covered are located on the *Government Page*.
 - IV. Must have a minimum 10 sources (APA Format), which must have its own page.
 - V. Remember all the projects must be presented in your website.
 - VI. Remember this is demonstrate your research and writing skills
 - VII. Remember to review your previous projects and make corrections, if necessary.
3. Write a **500-word narrative essay** on the process of the project. (ie., how did the student develop and produce the final project)
