



Component of Discovery: Social



Definition:

Social includes how people organize themselves in society, that is, the interrelationships among individuals, groups with individuals, and with other groups, including gender structure. A society results initially from the need to cooperate in order to survive.

Consider:

1. What is the class structure?
 - I. What role or need does the class fill in society?
 - II. Who is considered upper class?
 - III. Why do people regard the upper class more over than others?
2. What family structure do they have?
 - I. What is the role of maternal (mother) and paternal (father)?
 - II. What is the role of women and wives?
3. What education system does the society have that maintains the social structure?
 - I. Who is educated?
 - II. What is most emphasized in the education process?
